

MURRAY VALLEY CITRUS BOARD

Call for Board Members

The term of office of the current Board will expire on 30 June 2012. Applications are now sought from interested persons for the following part-time positions:

Four positions for citrus growers to represent the interests of citrus growers in the Murray Valley region of New South Wales and Victoria; and

Three positions for persons with expertise that is relevant and useful to the Board's core business (e.g. finance, legal, governance, supply chain, etc) these persons may also be growers.

The Board is funded by growers and is established under Victorian legislation to promote the best interests of the citrus industry in the Murray Valley of NSW and Victoria. It holds about 9 meetings a year in Mildura where it has an office with administrative and industry development staff.

The term of appointment is expected to be four years from 1 July 2012 and remuneration is in accordance with Victorian Government guidelines.

Interviews will be conducted in Mildura in February/March 2012 (or by appointment) by a Selection Panel. The Panel will make recommendations to the Victorian Minister for Agriculture regarding the most suitable candidates.

Applications, including a resume of qualifications and experience, should reach the Selection Panel by COB **30 January 2012**. The Victorian Government is seeking to increase the representation of women and Aboriginal people on Statutory Boards and encourages suitably qualified women and Aboriginal people to apply.
