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**SUBJECT: Korean Citrus Season 2006 Participation**

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*Dear Exporter,*

The Australian Horticultural Exporters' Association Inc. [AHEA] on behalf of Industry will again coordinate the cold disinfestation Inspections for citrus exported to Korea for the 2005 season.

Exporters should register their interest in participating in the 2005 season **no later than 4.00pm Wednesday 3rd May 2005** on the application form attached.

A Participation deposit will be required, and will be advised as soon as the number of participants are known, but will not be less than \$6,600.00 incl. GST per exporter.

Shipments presented for pre treatment and post treatment inspection by the Korean NPQS inspector will be further invoiced to the Exporter, on a bi-weekly basis at an agreed levy rate per standard citrus carton inspected to be advised.

Before commencement of the season, all participants will further agree to conditions of access to the Korean Inspector through an agreement for inspection of citrus fruit for export with the AHEA's service coordinator, Australian Horticulture Export Import Services Pty Ltd (AHEIS).

The AHEA in conjunction with exporters will decide on the official commencement date for the Inspections of citrus for export to Korea, after consultation with all Participants.

### **EXPORTERS NEED TO BE MINDFUL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

- Fullers Rose Weevil
- Fumigation on arrival has not been agreed.
- Citrus fruit should only be sourced from growers that are registered with AQIS and that monitor orchards for 4 diseases of concern to Korea ( *Mycosphaerella citri*, *Pythophthora citricola*, *Phytophthora hibernailis*, *Septoria citri*).
